Els for Autism was established in 2009 by Former World No.1, World Golf Hall of Famer, and four-time Major Champion, Ernie Els, his wife, Liezl, and Publisher and Founder of M. Shanken Communications Marvin R. Shanken. The Els' son, Ben, is impacted by autism, which affects 1 in 31 children in the United States*. The Els' daughter, Samantha (Sam), also plays an active role in the organization as the co-founder of our sibling support group, Sam's Sibs Stick Together.

Els for Autism offers innovative, evidencebased programs for families and individuals across the lifespan in three primary impact areas: Early Intervention & Educational Services, Recreation Services, and Adult Services.





We serve families around the world, offering virtual services and in-person programs and services at The Els Center of Excellence campus in Jupiter, Florida. The center is a world-class, 26-acre campus that is home to two separate nonprofit organizations: Els for Autism and The Learning Academy, a tuition-free, nonprofit Palm Beach County public charter school serving students with ASD ages 3 to 21.




The Els Center of Excellence[®] in Jupiter, FL is dedicated to empowering individuals with autism to lead healthy, active, and fulfilling lives. While our campus already features a range of outdoor sports and recreation spaces, we recognize that true health and well-being require consistent, year-round access to fitness, sports, and life skills programming—regardless of weather, time of day, or season.







Many individuals with autism face significant barriers to accessing traditional fitness and recreation programs, resulting in higher rates of obesity, diabetes, and other preventable health challenges. Our new Specialized Autism Friendly Recreation Complex will break down these barriers, providing a safe, supportive, and sensory-friendly environment where individuals of all ages and abilities can develop lifelong habits of health, fitness, and social connection.



A LIFE-SAVING AQUATIC CENTER

Preventing Tragedy, Building Confidence

Drowning is the #1 cause of death for young children with autism, and Florida tragically leads the nation in autism-related drownings. Wandering and water fascination are common among children on the spectrum, making water safety education not just beneficial, but absolutely essential.





Our new Aquatic Center will be a cornerstone of the Recreation Complex, offering:


- Specialized Water Safety Instruction: Evidence-based, autism-specific swim lessons and water safety programs delivered by highly trained instructors.
- **Year-Round Access:** A temperature-controlled environment ensures consistent instruction and practice, regardless of season.
- Family and Community Education: Workshops and resources for families and caregivers to reinforce water safety skills at home and in the community.


By equipping individuals with autism—and their families—with critical water safety skills, we are not only promoting health and recreation but also saving lives.

Transforming Health Outcomes


- Year-Round Fitness: The

SAFETY, INCLUSION, AND EMPOWERMENT

- **ASPECTSS**[®] **Design:** Built for sensory safety and inclusion, the complex will set a new national benchmark for accessible recreation.
- **Lifesaving Skills:** The Aquatic Center will address the leading cause of accidental death among children with autism—providing life-saving impact locally and beyond.



Acoustics

The strategic use of specially designed materials to reduce echoes and limit noise transfer between spaces.

TRANSITION SPACES

In a gradient of sensory opportunity and level of enclosure, transition spaces allow preparation prior to entering activities

SPATIAL SEQUENCING

An organization of the spaces and rooms of the building to flow in a predictable manner.

SENSORY PERCHES

Intended to help support predictability, planning, comfort and reduced anxiety prior to engaging in gym activities

ESCAPE SPACES

For sensory respite and regulation, these are from within a space and allow for needed sensory regulation without isolation from social activities and engagement with the group.

Sensory zoning

An organization of the design of the building in a manner that clusters quiet activities away from high sensory stimulation areas

COMPARTMENTALIZATION

A logical subdivision and organization of spaces to limit sensory overload and distractions.

SAFETY

The building is organized with a single main entry point to allow maximum supervision, with ontrolled exits with clear sight lines and double control points leading to the water area.
